Read&Write for Google (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dual color highlighting with TTS • TTS • Works with Google docs • Translates single words • Select voice, speaking rate, continuous reading and language for translating • Subscription works on webpages, PDF and ePub files • Subscription includes talking dictionary, picture dictionary, highlighter and more 	Free for 1 year for teachers Trial for 30 days After trial, TTS and translator available Special pricing for students and educational domains \$3-\$10/student
SpeakIt! (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reads highlighted text on web aloud 	Doesn't read apostrophes and dashes correctly. Seems to have a limit to the amount of text it will read consecutively.
ChromeVox (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reads text under cursor • Announces item type i.e., list, article, # of items 	
Natural Reader (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can select voice and speed • Copy and paste text into window • Or use bookmarklet 	Text highlighting is sometimes off
Chrome Speak (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can select voice, rate, pitch, volume • Select text & right click

Full Page Zoom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keyboard commands Control ++, Control +- or Control +0 • Chrome page menu 	
Adjust font face & size	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Settings – advanced – web content 	
ChromeVis (by Google) (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Magnify and change color of any selected text • Has keyboard shortcuts (i.e., toggle lens on/off with 0, increase text size with =, decrease with -) 	
Adblock Plus (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prevents ads from running on sites 	
Adblock for YouTube (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prevents ad from running at start of video and in the listing on the right 	
Turn Off the Lights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watch YouTube videos on screen with sidebars and comments dimmed. 	
Readability (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use to de-clutter web articles 	
High Contrast (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Converts screen to white text on black 	
Hacker Vision (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Converts screen to yellow and gray text on black

Radium (ePub reader)(app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Download epub format • Open Radium – Add book to library from web or a file already downloaded 	(www.epub.com or www.tarheelreader.org) Add text-to-speech with SpeakIt! Or ChromeSpeak
Clipped	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides 3 main ideas from online text 	
SummarizeThis (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copy and paste text into window 	
TLDR (Too Long Didn't Read) (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides real-time summaries of news articles or web pages • Can choose short, medium or long 	Short seemed to miss the main idea Can pair with SpeakIt! For TTS

Voice Recorder (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Record audio • Can do some trimming • Save to computer 	
PDFescape (app or ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Type on PDF • Create new PDF 	Files must be less than 10 MD and less than 100 pages Files get removed after 7 days of inactivity Has premium option that is ad free and extra storage

CoWriter Universal (app or extension)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Premier word prediction. • Works based in Cloud • Use on iPad app, laptop or Chromebook 	<p>Use extension for writing on websites, blogs, email & Google drive. Use app with built-in word processor</p> <p>Not free.</p>
Ginger (app or extension)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contextual Grammar Checker • Spell Checker • Synonyms • Translates • Dictionary • Rephrases 	<p>Has premium version that includes TTS Can autostart with Windows</p>
MindMup (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free Mindmapping • Dropbox or Google Storage • Real time collaborative • Create storyboards 	

SPEECH RECOGNITION

TITLE	DESCRIPTION	COMMENTS
Speechpad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Has text field for recognition • Can download docs • Inconsistent recognition for punctuation 	Improved recognition with use of headset microphone
Dictanote (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Saves only one note in the cloud • Have to register • Understands , . ? and ! • Has basic word processing commands within window 	Recognition is pretty good, but trouble with line commands

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use CTL + Z as an undo 	
Voice Recognition (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can export to Dropbox, Google drive, or email. Also save to computer. 	Does not handle commands for punctuation or line changes
VoiceNote (app)		Would not use. The menu item is off the side of the screen. It seems to miss first words of sentences and requires a repeat of speech every other time.

New Tab to Tasks (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click new tab and this extension brings in your Task list from Google. 	
Diigo Web Collector (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bookmark web pages • Annotate using sticky notes and highlighting • Search your library for all annotations or highlights • Share with others 	<p>Need to create account</p> <p>Save to Diigo (right click) – designate read later or upload a copy of the page</p> <p>Single click icon to link to library</p>
Scribe Toolbar (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Annotate using sticky notes and highlighting • Categorize annotations by type and color • Share with others via email • Save to library and search within library • Student version – capture citations and create bibliographies, 250 MB space, share libraries 	<p>Need to create account</p> <p>Student account available 250 MB free</p> <p>Instructor edition available</p> <p>125 MB storage free</p> <p>Does not interact with flash content</p>

Send Anywhere File Transfer (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share files with handheld devices with QR code or numeric code 	Uses app (iPhone or Android) or can identify available devices nearby and sends text. User then agrees to accept the doc.
Citelighter (ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use toolbar to collect facts for research projects. • Highlights information • Creates citations in MLA, APA or Chicago formats • Reorder the facts, add notes, create an outline • Export to Word, Google docs or email • Information stored in cloud • Settings has keyboard shortcuts 	Works with Chrome, Safari and Firefox Need to create account Has Pro version that allows citation of PDFs (Firefox only), access to reference publications, newspapers, journals, and storage of unlimited projects. \$10/month, \$80/year.
MyStudyLife (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create class schedule • Keep track of assignments/exams • Keep task list 	

ORGANIZATION - TIMERS

TITLE	DESCRIPTION	COMMENTS
Timer (Kuba Szulaczkowski)(ext)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Installs in increments of 1,5,10 & 120 min, but can change to amounts • Shows popup when completed with auditory sound 	
Timer (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set alarm, stopwatch and countdown • Uses YouTube chime, but can select alternative • Requires user to click to stop chime 	
Progress Bar Timer (app)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gives visual of time left (timer bar or clock bar) • Popup appears when time is up
